## 1. Dispatch of Japan Disaster Relief (JDR) Medical Team

- On March 31, Assessment Team was dispatched to Myanmar
- On April 2, JDR Medical Team was dispatched and arrived (32 members, including doctors and nurses)

## 2. Provision of Emergency Relief Goods

- On March 30, 240 water-proof sheets and 450 tents, stocked by Disaster Emergency Logistics System for ASEAN (DELSA), <u>funded by Japan-ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF)</u>, were delivered
- <u>Decided to distribute essential goods</u> (sanitary items, water, and water purifiers etc.) to the people affected by disasters through JICA

## 3. Emergency Grant

• On April 2, the Government of Japan announced that <u>Japan is prepared to implement</u> <u>Emergency Grant of approximately 6 million US dollars through international</u> organizations (the details will be coordinated with relevant international organizations)
