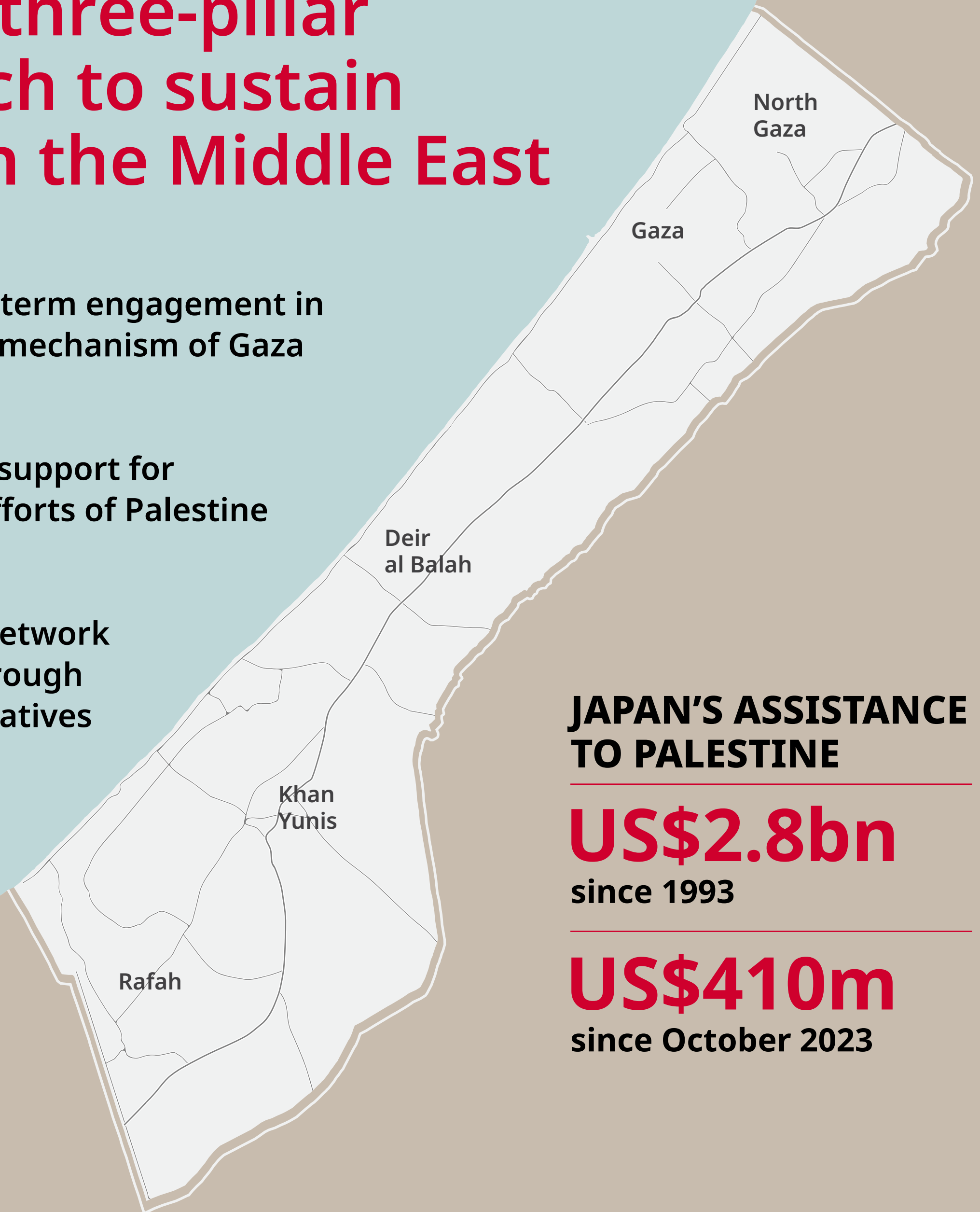

▶ **Ambassador OKUBO Takeshi** has assumed a newly created post as Japan's Special Assistant to the Minister for Foreign Affairs, **Ambassador in charge of Gaza Rebuilding Assistance**.

▶ **Japan contributes to the coordination of humanitarian assistance** with international partners including Civil-Military Coordination Center (CMCC).

Japan works with intergovernmental organisations and NGOs to implement projects in areas such as food, water, health, medical care and human resource development for the benefit for all Palestinians, including those in neighbouring countries.

## Did you know?

▶ **Through JICA**, Japan provides equipment and materials for waste disposal, improvement of health and medical systems, and restoration of water and sewage systems.

▶ **Working with UNDP and UNMAS**, Japan supports projects for rubble removal and unexploded ordnance disposals in Gaza.

▶ **Organizing symposiums** towards effective collaboration between public support and private investment **for the reconstruction of Gaza.**

Japan expands the existing circle of support through its own initiatives and conferences aimed at ensuring peace and prosperity in Palestine.



Did you know?

▶ Japan remains a key driver of **CEAPAD\*** efforts, mobilizing Southeast Asian partners to address urgent Palestinian needs and support state-building.

▶ Through Japan's initiative of the **"Corridor for Peace and Prosperity"**, the Jerico Agri-Industrial Park has been developed, boosting Palestine's socio-economic growth.

▶ The **Japan-Palestine Development Fund** supports infrastructure development and capacity-building in Palestine.

**\*Conference on Cooperation among East Asian Countries for Palestinian Development (CEAPAD)**  
CEAPAD is a regional conference framework launched by Japan in 2013 to support the Palestinian state-building efforts by drawing on resources, knowledge, and experiences of economic development of the East Asian countries.
