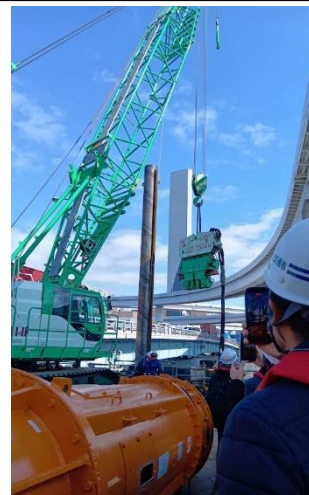

4. Voices from Participants (excerpt)

- ◆ Every site visit during the program was meaningful. Each one provided valuable knowledge and experiences, giving me the opportunity to compare and reflect on what can be learned and improved in my own country. I believe it is important not to view everything in my country as being wrong, but rather to learn from experiences such as those in Japan and identify best practices that can contribute to strengthening regional development. If I had to choose just one visit, however, I would select the visit to the Japan Meteorological Agency. I was particularly impressed by their ability to forecast and monitor various phenomena at both the national and local levels. This is certainly an area in which I would like to continue learning and deepen my knowledge.
