- Initiative on Assistance to Partner Countries for the Conservation of Biodiversity -

The initiative aims to assist partner countries who will commit to making efforts for the achievement of Post-2010 Targets.



Japan will provide assistance of two billion US Dollars in fields contributing to biodiversity conservation in three years beginning in 2010.

Priority Areas

1. Conservation of Ecosystem

It promotes adequate management of protected areas and pursue a balance between livelihood and natural environment conservation.

2. Sustainable use of natural resources

It supports halting a loss of biodiversity by the excessive use of natural resources through sustainable agriculture, forestry and fisheries.

3. Access to and Benefit Sharing of Genetic Resources

It enhances partner countries' capacity of exploring and preserving genetic resources for the expansion of benefit-sharing.
