Open five days a week for movement of authorized goods.

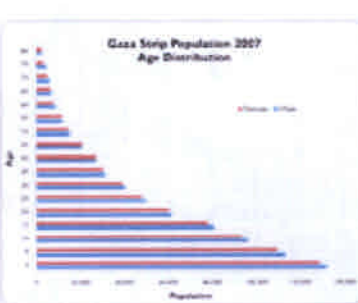

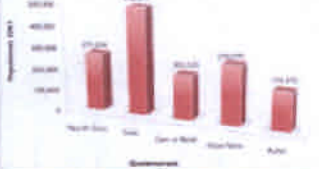
