- Demand and incentive for evaluation / bridge between evaluation and policy making
- Institutions such as law, rule, manual, guideline / players behavior may change
- Organizational custom, culture, tradition / awareness
- Clear roles and responsibilities

4. Several aspects of Evaluation Capacity Development (2)

- Learning organization / opportunities for host organizations
- Reliable information
- Independence and neutrality of evaluation Dept. and evaluators
- Human resource / knowledge and experiences
- Professional career / certification

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4. Several aspects of Evaluation Capacity Development (3)

- Correct incentives for evaluators to implement high quality of evaluation
- Ethics (Responsibilities for General and Public Welfare / Integrity / Respect for people / Independence / Systematic inquiry / Utility / Competence)
- Others
