Laos-Japan Friendship Bridge spans Xekong development divide

Lamam district, Xekong province: Connecting both sides of the Xekong River to provide a road link between neighbouring Lamam and Dakcheung districts in Xekong province, the new Laos-Japan Friendship Bridge was officially opened to the public on Monday.

The bridge is expected to greatly benefit local people in the province as well as facilitate improved domestic and international overland transportation.

A handover ceremony took place in Xekong province on Monday and was attended by Deputy Prime Chitmany, Minister of Public Japan to Laos, Mr Takeshi and Champassak provinces.
