How the National Development Policies are evaluated?

- 8 countries replied that the NDP is evaluated by a line Ministry under a policy or a framework.
- 1 country replied that the NDP is evaluated by a number of Ministries.
- 1 country replied that government is evaluating NDP by signing a contract with the Civil Organization Society.

Difficulties for Evaluating the NDP:

- 6 countries said they had a limitation of reliable data.
- 4 countries replied a lack of coordination amongst stakeholders.
- 3 countries replied lack of evaluation experts.
- 3 countries replied low level of technical capacities of the evaluation organization.

How the SDGs are Monitored:

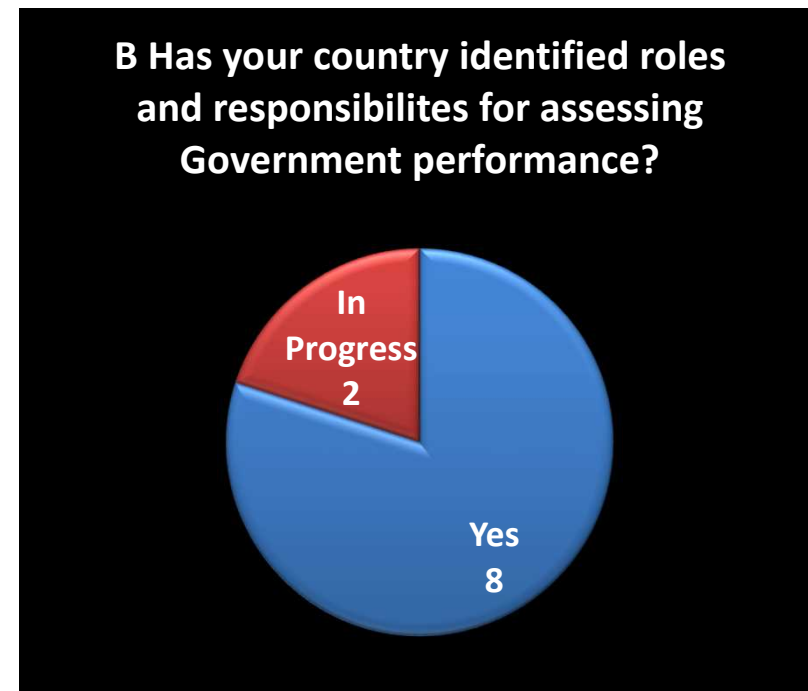
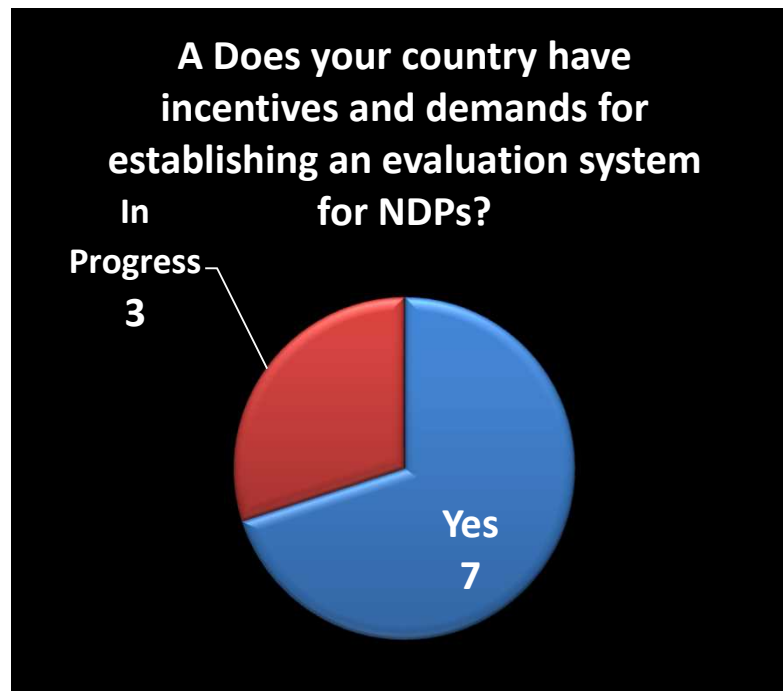
- 5 countries replied the SDGs are monitored by lead Ministries/Offices.
- 5 Countries replied that they are preparing guidelines/frameworks.
- 3 Countries replied that the SDGs have been localized in the country's context.
- 2 Countries replied they have prepared policy acts for the monitoring of the SDGs.

Difficulties for Monitoring the SDGs

- 8 countries replied limitation of reliable data.
- 3 countries replied lack of indicators.
- 3 countries replied lack of coordination amongst stakeholders.
- 2 countries replied lack of human resources.
- 2 countries replied low level of technical capacities.

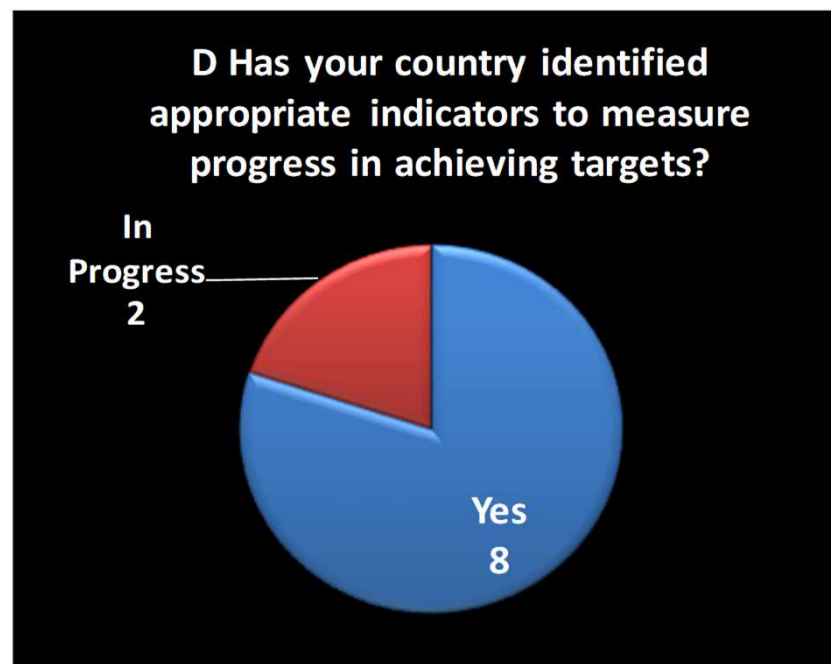
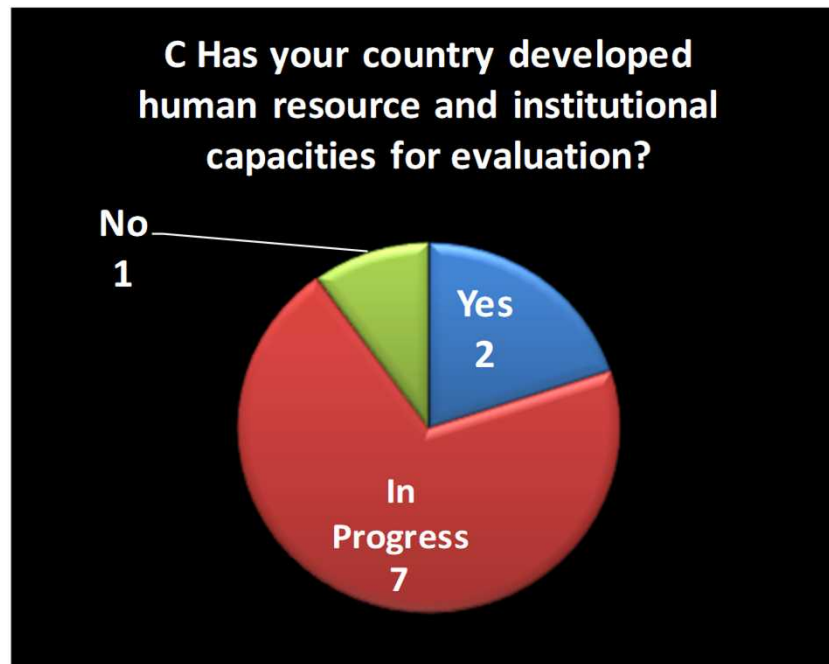

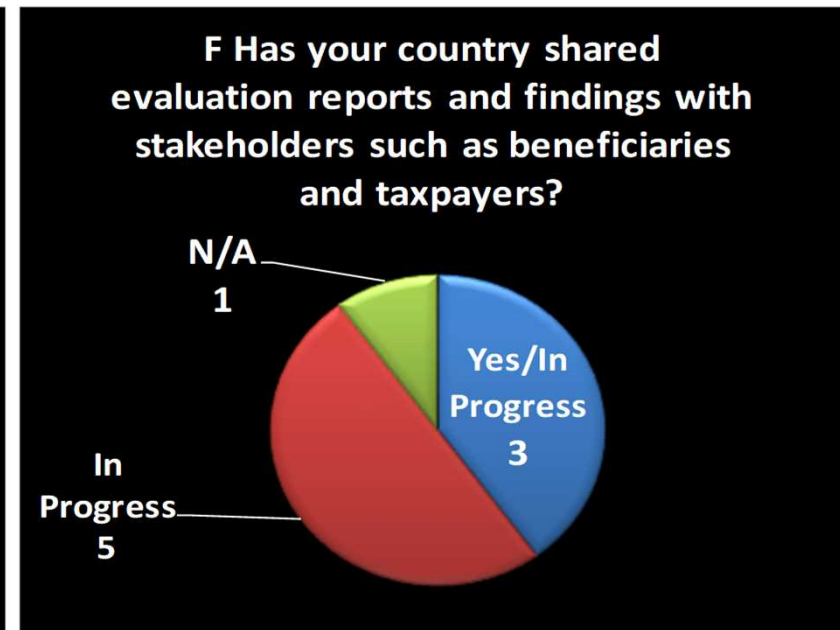
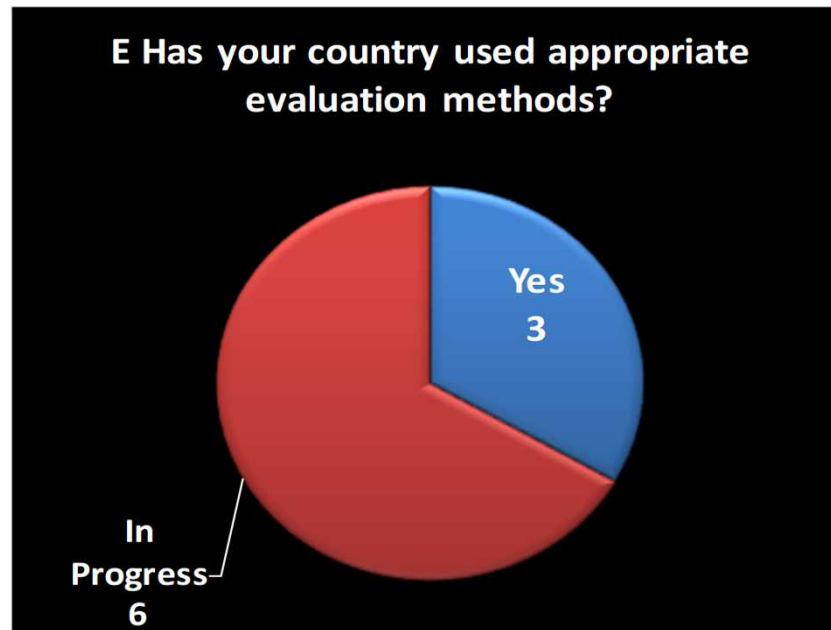

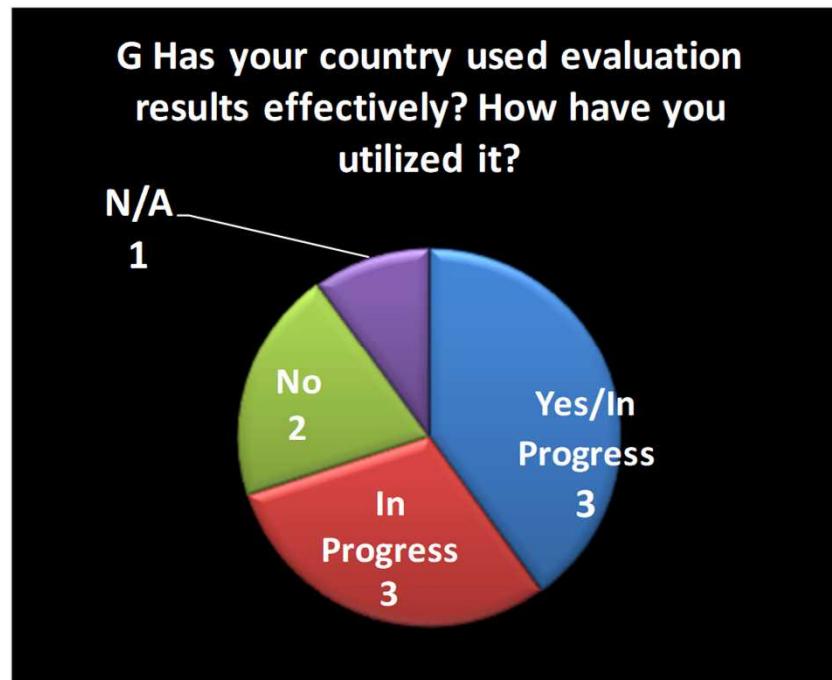

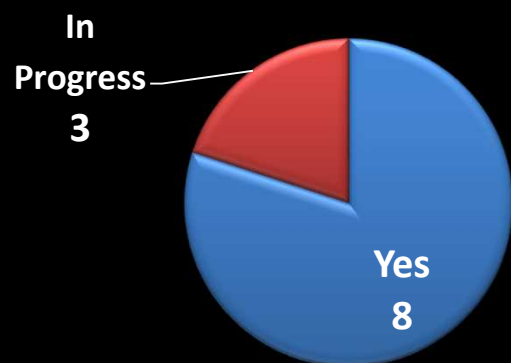

A Has your country developed its own national indicators to monitor progress made on the goals and targets?



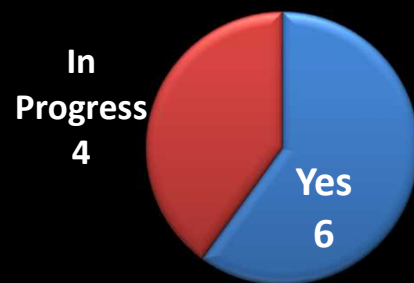
B Has your country established a data collection method, which includes usage of existing data?



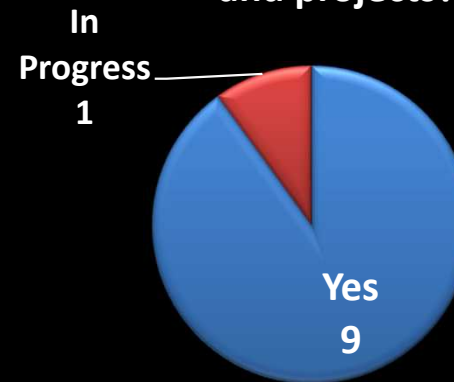

C Has your country established a systematic method to gather all indicators/data you answered above (A and B) in order to manage the progress of the SDGs achievement?

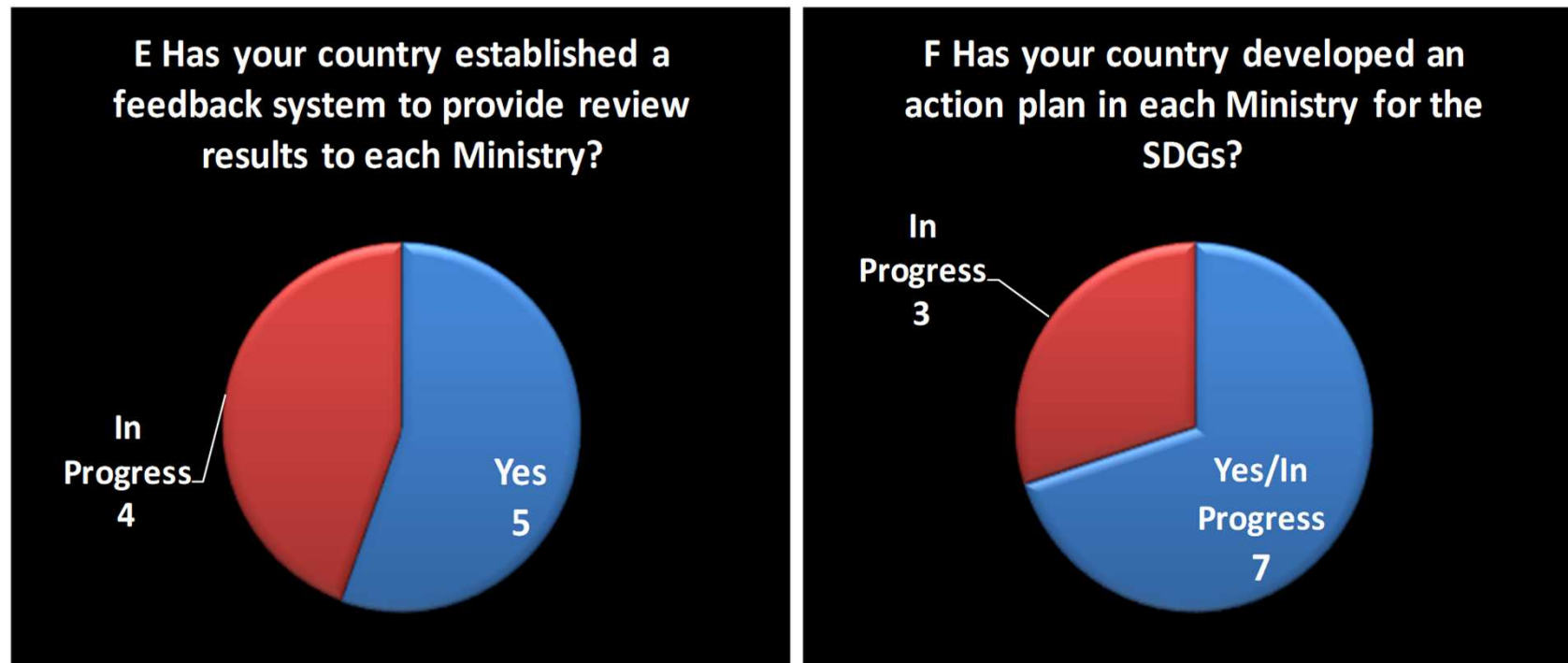


D Has your country made linkages between the achievement of the goals and targets of the SDGs and the National Development Strategy and projects?



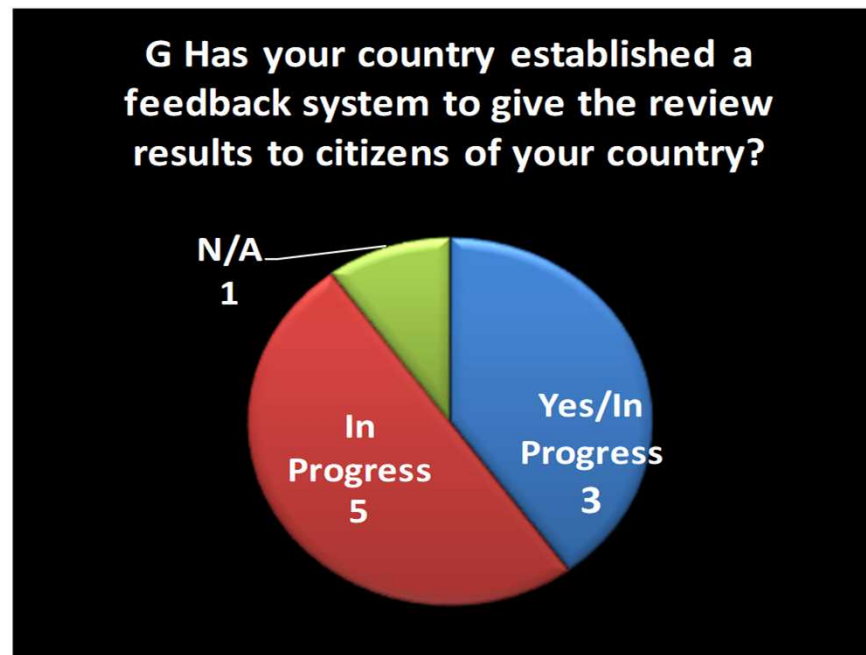
