# Concepts

Administrative and managerial workers: This group comprises individuals solely engaged in business management of whole business entities or internal organizations at section or higher level (including those equivalent to sections), such as deciding business management policy, establishing executive structures based on the management policy, and supervising and controlling operations. Elected government officials in various organs of the national government and local governments are also included. (Category A Administrative and managerial workers of JSOC Rev.5)

### Rationale and Interpretation:

Major group 1 of ISCO-88 and ISCO-08 could be used as a proxy. Category A Administrative and managerial workers of JSOC Rev.5 corresponds to Major group 1 of ISCO-88 and ISCO-08.
