Indicator Name, Target and Goal

Indicator 8.6.1 Proportion of youth (aged 15-24 years) not in education, employment or training

Target 8.6 By 2020, substantially reduce the proportion of youth not in employment, education or training

Goal 8 Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all

Definition and Rationale

Definition

Proportion of persons not in labour force nor attending school in population (aged 15 -24 years).

Concepts

Persons not in labour force nor attending school is sum of persons not in labour force (housekeeping) and persons not in labour force (other).

Rationale and Interpretation:

For there are no information regarding persons in training, number of persons not in labour force nor attending school is used as a proxy.

Data Sources and Collection Method

Labour Force Survey (Basic Tabulation)

Method of Computation and Other Methodological Considerations

Computation Method

Proportion of persons not in labour force nor attending school in population (aged 15 -24 years) =
$$\frac{\text{persons not in labour force (housekeeping) + persons not in labour force (other)(aged 15 – 24)}}{\text{population (aged 15 – 24)}}$$

Numbers could be obtained from Table I-2 of Labour Force Survey (Basic Tabulation).

Comments and limitations

There are no information regarding persons in training. Unemployed

persons are NOT included in numerator.
