Definition and Rationale

Definition

Proportion of employed person in manufacturing industries in the total employed person.

Concepts

Employed person: Employed person at work and Employed person not at work

Employed person at work: All persons who worked for pay or profit
Employed person not at work: Persons with jobs but not at work during
the reference week

Manufacturing: Industries belonging Division E in Japan Standard Industrial Classification (Rev. 13, October 2013).

Rationale and Interpretation:

This indicator conveys the contribution of manufacturing in total employment.

Data Sources and Collection Method

Labour Force Survey (Basic Tabulation)

Method of Computation and Other Methodological Considerations

Computation Method

Proportion of employed person in manufacturing industries in the total employed person

= Employed person in Manufacturing industries (Division E of JSIC Rev.13)/ Total employed person * 100

Numbers could be obtained from Table II-2-1, II-5 and Regional Table 1 of Labour Force Survey (Basic Tabulation).

Comments and limitations

Industrial classification is based on Japan Standard Industrial Classification (Rev. 13, October 2013, JSIC). Manufacturing industries, Division E, in JSIC is much the same as Sector C in ISIC Rev.4.

Data Disaggregation

Disaggregation by sex, age group (five-year group), occupation and region are available.
