- Definition

With its Fundamental Plan for Establishing a Sound Material-Cycle Society in place, Japan can be regarded as a “country with sustainable consumption and production (SCP) national action plans.”

- Concepts

The Fundamental Plan for Establishing a Sound Material-Cycle Society provides basic policies concerning programs for the formation of a sound material-cycle society, and provides programs, etc. that the national government should implement in a comprehensive and systematic manner, on the basis of the Basic Act on Establishing a Sound Material-Cycle Society.

- Rationale and Interpretation

The Fundamental Plan for Establishing a Sound Material-Cycle Society is designed on the basis of the Basic Act on Establishing a Sound Material-Cycle Society aiming at realizing a sound material-cycle society in which the use of natural resources is minimized and environmental impacts are reduced to the greatest extent possible.
