Challenges towards an Appealing and Effective New Framework

◆ Build on the Strength of the Current MDGs

- **Simple, Clear, Easy-to-understand, Measurable**
(Review and consolidate goals, targets and indicators)
- **Poverty Eradication** to remain at its core

◆ Growth and Employment: A new focus

- Create **Wealth** for development
- **Quality Growth ('green' & 'inclusive')** should be pursued.

◆ Domestic Inequality: Our attention

- Three quarters of the world's poor now live in middle income countries.
- **Equity & Inclusiveness** = Key concepts

◆ Respond to Changes in the Past 10 Years

- Improve the goals, targets and indicators on major issues, including **Health** and **Education**.
 - ⇒ **Human Security** as a guiding principle
- Address **new challenges** such as **Disaster Reduction (→ Resilience)**, **Sustainability** and **Food Security/Nutrition**.
- Involve the **Private Sector**, **Emerging Countries** and the **Civil Society**.
 - ⇒ **New Partnership** based on **Mutual Support**
(Beyond the 'North' and the 'South' divide)
