

TVK, March 2nd:

On March 1st, at the Embassy of Japan there was a signing ceremony about the Japanese Cultural Project. The first Japanese Cultural Project was signed by H.E.Mr. Gotaro OGAWA, Ambassador of Japan to Cambodia and Mr. Yoshiaki ISHIZAWA, Chief of Sofia University Angkor International Mission, this project worth of US\$ 62,719 and the aim of the project is to improve the efficiency of works for the restoration of cultural heritage and the capacity of information processing.

On the same occasion, Ambassador of Japan signed the Grant for other 5 projects between 5 representatives:

- Battambang Provincial Service of Water Resources and Meteorology, the project to rehabilitate the irrigation system of Komping Puoy reservoir in Battambang Province.

- Foundation for International Development / Relief ( FIDR ), the project to construct school in Ang Khmao Primary school in Kompong Speu Province,

- International Volunteers of Yamagata, the project to hold emergency feed preparation seminar in Svay Rieng Province,

- Caring for Young Khmer ( CYK ), the project to support the regional center for Women and Children in Battambang Province and

- Takeo Provincial Services of Water Resources and Meteorology, the project to rehabilitate the access road to Svay Khorm reservoir in Takeo Province.

The six projects worth of US\$ 333,773.
