Japan Donates Money, Supplies to Schools

Schools in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap province will benefit from Japanese government donations worth almost \$250,000. More than 7,600 secondhand desks and chairs will be sent from Japan's Chiba and Hokkaido prefectures to 11 primary schools and four junior high schools and high schools in Phnom Penh. The money will also be used to construct one primary school classroom building in both Siem Reap and Phnom Penh. Another \$18,000 will be used to help build water Wells in Oddar Meanchey province.
