Japan Donates Money For Aid Projects

The Japanese government is providing more than \$333,000 for six projects in Cambodia, including the restoration of cultural heritage, irrigation systems, school buildings, road rehabilitation, and aiding women and children. Japanese Ambassador Gotaro Ogawa signed contracts Thursday formalizing the projects, which are part of the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grass-roots Projects and for Cultural Grassroots Projects. Since 1992, more than \$8 million has been provided to Cambodia under the Grassroots Projects. (Gina Chon)
