- (3) The sole purpose of the account referred to in sub-paragraph (1) above is to receive the payments in Japanese yen by the Government of Japan and to pay to the Japanese nationals who are parties to the Verified Contracts. The procedural details concerning the credit to and debit from the account will be agreed upon through consultation between the Bank and the Government of the Republic of Maldives or its designated authority.
- 6. (1) The Government of the Republic of Maldives will take necessary measures:
- (a) to ensure prompt unloading and customs clearance at ports of disembarkation in the Republic of Maldives and prompt internal transportation therein of the rice purchased under the Grant;
- (b) to exempt Japanese nationals from customs duties, internal taxes and other fiscal levies which may be imposed in the Republic of Maldives with respect to the supply of the rice and services under the Verified Contracts;
- (c) to ensure that the rice purchased under the Grant will make effective contribution to the stabilization and development of the economy of the Republic of Maldives; and
- (d) to bear all the expenses, other than those to be borne by the Grant, necessary for the execution of the Grant including the transportation of the rice referred to in (a) of sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3.
- (2) With regard to the shipping and marine insurance of products purchased under the Grant, the Government of the Republic of Maldives will refrain from imposing any restrictions that may hinder fair and free

competition among the shipping and marine insurance companies.

- (3) The rice purchased under the Grant shall not be re-exported from the Republic of Maldives.
- 7. (1) The Government of the Republic of Maldives will deposit in Maldivian currency at least an amount equivalent to two-thirds of the yen disbursement paid with respect to the purchase of the rice referred to in (a) of sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 3 in an account to be opened in its name in the Maldivian Bank. The deposit shall be made within the period of three years from the date of coming into force of the present arrangements, unless otherwise agreed between the authorities concerned of the two Governments.
- (2) The currency thus deposited shall be utilized for economic and social development purposes, including food production, in the Republic of Maldives.
- (3) The authorities concerned of the two Governments will consult with each other about the utilization of the currency deposited.
- 8. Further procedural details for the implementation of the present arrangements will be agreed upon through consultation between the authorities concerned of the two Governments.
- 9. The two Governments will consult with each other in respect of any matter that may arise from or in connection with the present arrangements.
- I have further the honour to propose that this Note and your Note in reply confirming on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Maldives the foregoing arrangements shall be

regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments, which will enter into force on the date of your reply.
