Dear Dr. Snan,

I have the honour to refer to the resolution 165 dated March 11, 1978 of the Third Part of the Ninth Special Session of the Trade and Development Board of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development regarding debt and development problems of developing countries and to the recent discussions held between the representatives of the Government of Japan and of His Majesty's Government of Nepal concerning Japanese economic cooperation to be extended to the Kingdom of Nepal with a view to strengthening friendly and cooperative relations between the two countries, and to propose on behalf of the Government of Japan the following arrangements:

- 1. Noting the debts of His Majesty's Government of Nepal under the loan agreement concluded in accordance with the Notes exchanged between the Government of Japan and His Majesty's Government of Nepal on the dates enumerated in the list attached to this Note, the Government of Japan will extend to His Majesty's Government of Nepal, in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of Japan, a grant of two hundred eight million six hundred fourteen thousand yen (¥208,614,000) (hereinafter referred to as "the Grant") for the purpose of contributing to the development of the economy of the Kingdom of Nepal and the enhancement of the welfare of its
- 2. (1) The Grant and its accrued interest will be used by His Majesty's Government of Nepal

properly and exclusively for the purchase of products enumerated in a list to be mutually agreed upon between the authorities concerned of the two Governments and services incidental to such products, provided that those products are produced in eligible source countries.

- (2) The list mentioned in sub-paragraph (1) above will be subject to modifications which may be agreed upon between the authorities concerned of the two Governments.
- (3) The scope of the eligible source countries mentioned in sub-paragraph (1) above will be agreed upon between the authorities concerned of the two Governments.
- 3. (1) His Majesty's Government of Nepal will open a free yen ordinary deposit account at an authorized foreign exchange bank of Japan in the name of His Majesty's Government of Nepal (hereinafter referred to as "the Account") within fourteen days after the date of coming into force of the present arrangements and will notify in writing the Government of Japan of the Account within seven days after the date of the opening of the Account.
- (2) The sole purpose of the Account is to receive the payment in Japanese yen by the Government of Japan referred to in paragraph 4 as well as to make payments necessary for the purchase of the products and services referred to in sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 2, and such other payment as may be agreed upon by the authorities concerned of the two Governments.
- 4. The Government of Japan will execute the Grant by making payment in Japanese yen of the amount referred to in paragraph 1 to the Account during the period between the date of receipt of the written notification referred to in
