#### (Japanese Note)

Islamabad, April 16, 1989

Excellency,

- I have the honour to refer to the recent discussions held between the representatives of the Government of Japan and of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan concerning Japanese economic cooperation to be extended with a view to strengthening friendly and cooperative relations between the two countries, and to propose on behalf of the Government of Japan the following arrangements:
- 1. For the purpose of contributing to the execution of the project for rehabilitation of the area suffering from the flood (hereinafter referred to as "the Project") by the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Government of Japan will extend to the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of Japan, a grant up to six hundred million yen (¥600,000,000) (hereinafter referred to as "the Grant").
- 2. The Grant will be made available during the period between the date of coming into force of the present arrangements and March 31, 1990, unless the period is extended by mutual agreement between the authorities concerned of the two Governments.
- 3. The Grant will be used by the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan properly and exclusively for the purchase of the products of Japan and the services listed below:
- (a) galvanized iron sheets necessary for the execution of the Project; and

- (b) services necessary for the transportation of the products referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above to ports in the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
- 4. The Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan or its designated authority will enter into contracts in Japanese yen with Japanese nationals for the purchase of the products and services referred to in paragraph 3. Such contracts shall be verified by the Government of Japan to be eligible for the Grant. (The term Japanese nationals when- ever used in the present arrangements means Japanese physical persons or Japanese juridical persons controlled by Japanese physical persons.)
- the Grant by making payments in Japan will execute the Grant by making payments in Japanese yen to cover the obligations incurred by the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan or its designated authority under the contracts verified in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 (hereinafter referred to as "the Verified Contracts") to an account to be opened in the name of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan in an authorized foreign exchange bank of Japan designated by the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan or its designated authority (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank").
- (2) The payments referred to in subparagraph (1) above will be made when payment requests are presented by the Bank to the Government of Japan under an authorization to pay issued by the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan or its designated authority.
- (3) The sole purpose of the account referred to in sub-paragraph (1) above is to
