Excellency,

- I have the honour to refer to the resolution 165 dated March 11, 1978 of the Third Part of the Ninth Special Session of the Trade and Development Board of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development regarding debt and development problems of developing countries and to the recent discussions held between the representatives of the Government of Japan and of the Government of Japan and of the economic cooperation to be extended to India with a view to strengthening friendly and cooperative relations between the two countries, and to propose on behalf of the Government of Japan the following arrangements:
- 1. Noting the debts of the Government of India under the loan agreements concluded in accordance with the notes exchanged between the Government of Japan and the Government of India on the dates enumerated in the list attached to this Note, the Government of Japan will extend to the Government of India, in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of Japan, a grant of four hundred thirty-nine million two hundred seventy-six thousand yen (¥439,276,000) (hereinafter referred to as "the Grant") for the purpose of India and the enhancement of the welfare of its people.
- 2. (1) The Grant and its accrued interest will be used by the Government of India properly and exclusively for the purchase of products

enumerated in a list to be mutually agreed upon between the authorities concerned of the two Governments and services incidental to such products, provided that those products are produced in eligible source countries.

(2) The list mentioned in sub-paragraph (1) above will be subject to modifications which may be agreed upon between the authorities concerned of the two Governments.

(3) The scope of the eligible source countries mentioned in sub-paragraph (1) above

will be agreed upon between the authorities concerned of the two Governments.

(1) The Government of India will open a yen ordinary deposit account at an authorized foreign exchange bank of Japan in the name of the Government of India (hereinafter referred to as "the Account") within fourteen days after the date of coming into force of the present arrangements and will notify in writing the Government of Japan of the completion of the procedure for opening the Account within seven days after the date of
