- (2) The payments referred to in subparagraph (1) above will be made when payment
 requests are presented by the Bank to the
 Government of Japan under an authorization to
 pay issued by His Majesty's Government of
 Nepal or its designated authority.
- (3) The sole purpose of the account referred to in sub-paragraph (1) above is to receive the payments in Japanese yen by the Government of Japan and to pay to the Japanese nationals who are parties to the Verified Contracts. The procedural details concerning the credit to and debit from the account will be agreed upon through consultation between the Bank and His Majesty's Government of Nepal or its designated authority.
- 6. (1) His Majesty's Government of Nepal will take necessary measures:
- (a) to ensure prompt customs clearance and internal transportation in the Kingdom of Nepal of the products purchased under the Grant;
- (b) to exempt Japanese nationals from customs duties, internal taxes and other fiscal levies which may be imposed in the Kingdom of Nepal with respect to the supply of the products and services under the Verified Contracts;

- (c) to accord Japanese nationals whose services may be required in connection with the supply of the products and services under the Verified Contracts such facilities as may be necessary for their entry into the Kingdom of Nepal and stay therein for the performance of their work;
- (d) to ensure that the products purchased under the Grant be maintained and used properly and effectively for the execution of the Project; and
- (e) to bear all the expenses, other than those covered by the Grant, necessary for the execution of the Project.
- (2) With regard to the shipping and marine insurance of products purchased under the Grant, His Majesty's Government of Nepal will refrain from imposing any restrictions that may hinder fair and free competition among the shipping and marine insurance companies.
- (3) The products purchased under the Grant shall not be re-exported from the Kingdom of Nepal.
- 7. The two Governments will consult with each other in respect of any matter that may arise from or in connection with the present arrangements.

I have further the honour to propose that this Note and your Note in reply confirming on behalf of His Majesty's Government of Nepal the foregoing arrangements shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments, which will enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to you the assurance of my high consideration.
