- 5. (1) The Government of Japan will execute the Grant by making payments in Japanese yen to cover the obligations incurred by the Royal Government of Bhutan or its designated authority under the contracts verified in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 (hereinafter referred to as "the Verified Contracts") to an account to be opened in the name of the Royal Government of Bhutan in an authorized foreign exchange bank of Japan designated by the Royal Government of Bhutan or its designated authority (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank").
- (2) The payments referred to in sub-paragraph (1) above will be made when payment requests are presented by the Bank to the Royal Government of Japan under an authorization to pay issued by the Royal Government of Bhutan or its designated authority.
- referred to in sub-paragraph (1) above is to receive the payments in Japanese yen by the Government of Japan and to pay to the Japanese nationals who are parties to the Verified Contracts. The procedural details concerning the credit to and debit from the account will be agreed upon through consultation between the Bank and the Royal Government of Bhutan or its designated authority.
- 6. (1) The Royal Government of Bhutan will take necessary measures:
- (a) to secure a lot of land necessary for the construction of the Facilities and to clear the site;

- (b) to provide facilities for distribution of electricity, water supply and drainage and other incidental facilities outside the site;
- (c) to ensure prompt customs clearance in the Kingdom of Bhutan and internal transportation therein of the products purchased under the Grant;
- (d) to exempt Japanese nationals from customs duties, internal taxes and other fiscal levies which may be imposed in the Kingdom of Bhutan with respect to the supply of the products and services under the Verified Contracts;
- (e) to accord Japanese nationals whose services may be required in connection with the supply of the products and services under the Verified Contracts such facilities as may be necessary for their entry into the Kingdom of Bhutan and stay therein for the performance of their work;
- (f) to ensure that the Facilities constructed and the products purchased under the Grant be maintained and used properly and effectively for the execution of the Project; and
- (g) to bear all the expenses, other than those covered by the Grant, necessary for the execution of the Project.
- (2) With regard to the shipping and marine insurance of products purchased under the Grant, the Royal Government of Bhutan will refrain from imposing any restrictions that may hinder fair and free competition among the shipping and marine insurance companies.
- (3) The products purchased under the Grant shall not be re-exported from the Kingdom of Bhutan.

7. The two Governments will consult with each other in respect of any matter that may arise from or in connection with the present arrangements.

I have further the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's Note in reply confirming on behalf of the Royal Government of Bhutan the foregoing arrangements shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments, which will enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
