I have the honour to refer to the recent discussions held between the representatives of the Government of Japan and of the Government of the Republic of the Philippines arrangements: relations between the two countries, and to propose on behalf of the Government of Japan the following with a view to strengthening friendly and cooperative concerning Japanese economic cooperation to be extended
