- the project for Development of Fisheries in Noro (hereinafter referred to as "the Project") by the Government of Solomon Islands, the Government of Japan will extend to the Government of Solomon Islands, in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations of Japan, a grant up to two hundred and twenty-four yen (#224,000,000) (hereinafter referred to as "the Grant"). - 2. The Grant will be made available during the period between the date of coming into force of the present arrangements and March 31, 1996, unless the period is extended by mutual agreement between the authorities concerned of the two Governments.

- (d) to ensure that the products purchased under the Grant be maintained and used properly and effectively for the execution of the Project; and
- (e) to bear all the expenses, other than those covered by the Grant, necessary for the execution of the project.
- (2) With regard to the shipping and marine insurance of products purchased under the Grant, the Government of Solomon Islands will refrain from imposing any restrictions that may hinder fair and free competition among the shipping and marine insurance companies.
- (3) The products purchased under the Grant shall not be re-exported from Solomon Islands.
- 7. The two Governments will consult with each other in respect of any matter that may arise from or in connection with the present arrangements.

I have further the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's Note in reply confirming on behalf of the Government of Solomon Islands the foregoing arrangements shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments, which will enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
