Keidanren's Proposal on Movement of Natural Persons

- **◆ WTO Service Negotiations started in 2000**
- ◆ Keidanren submitted proposal in June 2002 "Proposal concerning the Movement of Natural Persons"
- Based on answers on questionnaire from Japanese companies
- Keidanren requested governments to liberalize movement of natural persons

Problems Japanese Companies Face

- Japanese legal system hinders smooth movement of natural persons
 - Intra-company transfer restricted
 - Minimum 1-year experience request
 - Not permitted for training purpose
 - Restrictions on foreign trainees on work time, etc
 - Dispatch business by foreign agents restricted
 - Foreign workers in medical area restricted
- Visa issuance for Asians by Japanese Gov-t: slow, not transparent

Keidanren's New Vision (published in January 2003)

- Free movement of five elements for production
 - 1. Goods
 - 2. Service
 - 3. Money
 - 4. Information
 - 5. Natural persons

Keidanren's New Vision

(Requests on the Movement of Natural Persons)

- (1) Further liberalize movement of highskilled labor, intra-company transfer, for training purpose, contract-based persons
 - Further develop APEC Business Travel Card type ideas
- (2) Improve Visa issuance system for students and tourists
- (3) Mutual Recognition of qualifications for lawyers, accountant, doctors, technicians, architects, care-takers
