

G7 Sustainable Urban Development Ministers' Meeting in Takamatsu, Kagawa

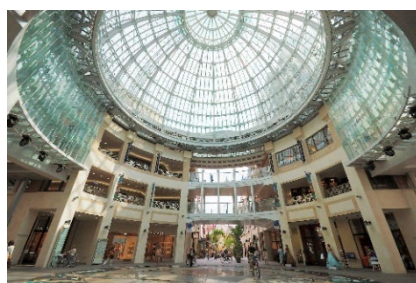
