

G7 Foreign Ministers' Meeting in Karuizawa, Nagano MOFA Japan

- Date : Sunday, April 16 - Tuesday, April 18, 2023
- Venue : Karuizawa, Nagano Prefecture
- Participants : Foreign Ministers of the G7(Japan, Italy, Canada, France, United States of America, United Kingdom, Germany) and the EU High Representative
- Objective : To exchange candid views on pressing international challenges and regional affairs.

G7 Foreign Ministers' Meeting under the German Presidency

Under the German Presidency, the G7 Foreign Ministers' Meetings took place in Weissenhaus, Germany, on May 12-14 and in Münster, Germany, on November 3-4, and exchanged in-depth views mainly on the situation in Ukraine and the Indo-Pacific.

Regional situations such as China, North Korea, the Middle East and Africa, and international challenges including pandemics, infrastructure development, and the climate crisis were also discussed.

At both meetings, a Foreign Ministers' Statement was issued as a outcome document.
