The ART Morocco Framework Programme: more than 75 development partners respond to the demands identified by local communities of the Tanger Tetuan region












The UNDP ART Initiative mechanisms (global level)



- ART promotes exchanges between cities/local authorities on issues of common interest
 - More than 600 decentralized partners (cities, regions, academia, private sector) using ART for integrated action at country level and globally.
 - South-South and triangular cooperation.
 - Mobilization of the cities /local social capital and expertise.
- Global debates: ART works with global networks of local and regional governments to position the local perspective in global debates:
 - **Busan HLF-4**: consultative process on aid effectiveness at the local level and joint organization with UCLG, FOGAR and DeLoG of a HLF-4 side event.
 - **Rio + 20:** territorial level consultations and joint events with FOGAR and UCLG to include the sub national perspective in the Rio+20 debate.
 - Local Economic Development: more than 1.200 participants in the I World Forum of Local Development Agencies. A Permanent forum for promoting LED established between UNDP ART and Spanish and Brazilian decentralized partners.
 - **Development Cooperation Forum:** for the first time Decentralized Cooperation is included in the discussions. ART organizing a DCF side event on the topic.

ART Lebanon: a framework for decentralized cooperation partners for promoting sustainable development in Lebanese territories

- •Local Economic Development: four LEDAs established that facilitate integrated economic development through active involvement of all relevant economic institutions/actors in the territories, e.g. South Beirut. The *regions and cities of Europe support the LEDAs* through a partnership with their own Development Agencies.
- •Water management and water infrastructures improvement: established sustainable water maintenance centers in South Lebanon and trained water technicians.
 - Lebanese water engineers and technicians were **trained in Italy by specialized Italian (Turin) experts.**
- •Waste management project: rehabilitation of waste treatment facilities in South Lebanon, with the support of European Decentralized Cooperation, priority identified by the regional working groups.
