- <u>All the companies and organizations based in Japan</u> making outstanding efforts, either domestically or internationally, to achieve SDGs, are eligible for the Award.
- The SDGs Promotion Headquarters decides award winners based on opinions of a wide-range of stakeholders who have expertise in the SDGs.
- Selection criteria are line bolds, universality, inclusiveness, participation, integration, and transparency and accountability, which are the main principles of the "SDGs Implementation Guidelines" stipulated by the Headquarters.
- The 4th Award ceremony took place at the Prime Minister's Office on Dec. 21, 2020.
