
Latest Developments and Experiences of the Bilaterals

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- Purpose: to let the trainees understand:

- 2trend of donor communities: "Do no harm"
- ③JICA's schemes
- Composition of training course:

- 21 week and half: field work abroad: Cambodia, East-Timor etc.

II. Present Stance (2006—)

Purpose:

to give lectures on JICA's schemes and some considerations to be made in the context of conflicts

Target:

those who have other expertise than peace-building and have a will to work for peace-building (ex. architecture, education, agriculture, health-care...)

- Composition of the training course:
 - 1 week: lectures and discussions in Japan
 - 2 2week: field work abroad: Cambodia, Palestine
- * generalists in peace-building activities

⇒cooperation of experts in various fields and areas on ad-hoc basis
