

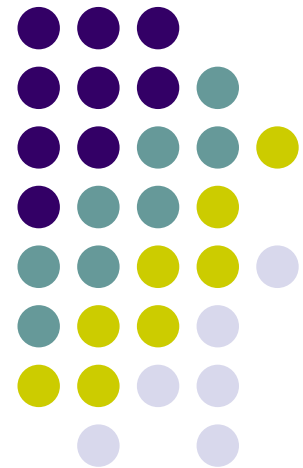
# Latest Developments and Experiences of the Bilaterals

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# I . Initial Stage (2004—2005)

- Purpose: to let the trainees understand:
  - ① notion of “peace-building”
  - ② trend of donor communities: “Do no harm”
  - ③ JICA’ s schemes
- Composition of training course:
  - ① 3 weeks and half: lectures and discussions in Japan
  - ② 1 week and half: field work abroad: Cambodia, East-Timor etc.
- Future of the trainees:

Chiefly project formulation advisors, project coordinators...
- Problems: **No regular job**

cannot keep good human resources for jobs not known when to come

## II . Present Stance (2006—)



- Purpose:  
to give lectures on JICA's schemes and some considerations to be made in the context of conflicts
- Target:  
those who have other expertise than peace-building and  
have a will to work for peace-building  
(ex. architecture, education, agriculture, health-care...)
- Composition of the training course:
  - ① 1 week: lectures and discussions in Japan
  - ② 2week: field work abroad: Cambodia, Palestine
- \* generalists in peace-building activities  
⇒ cooperation of experts in various fields and areas on ad-hoc basis
