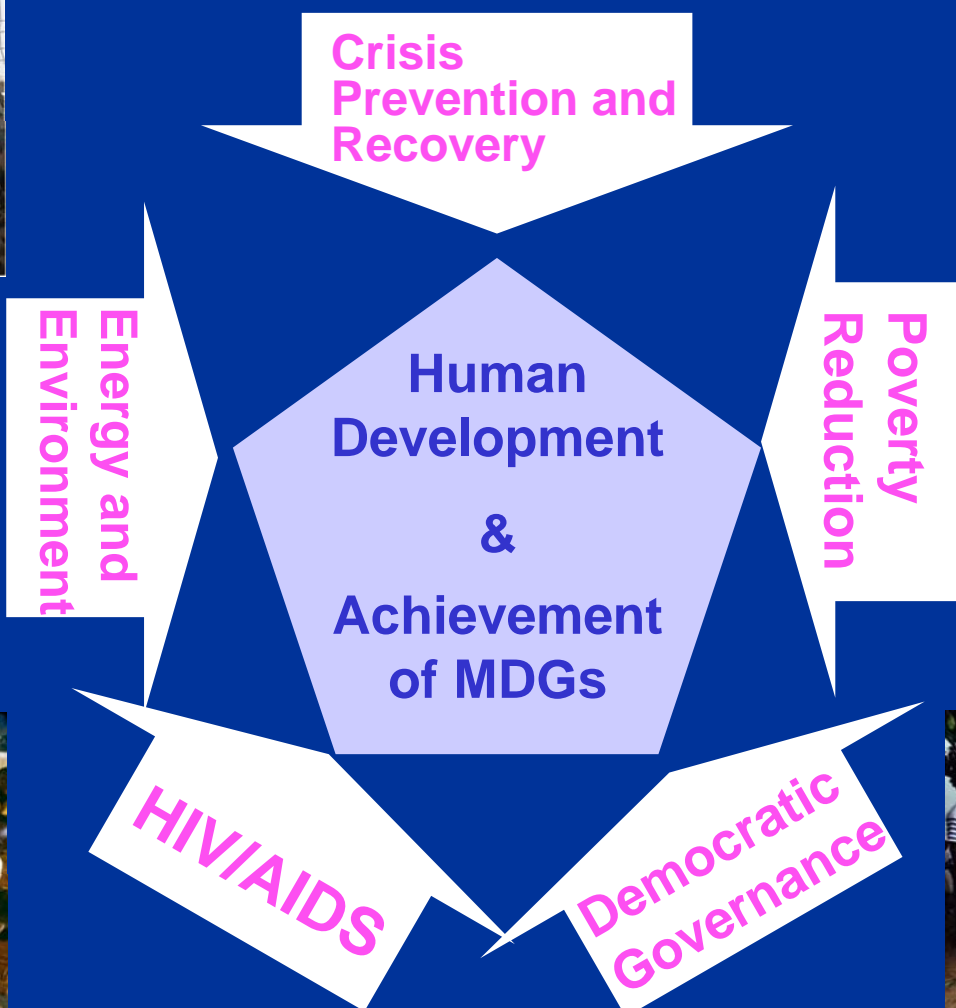
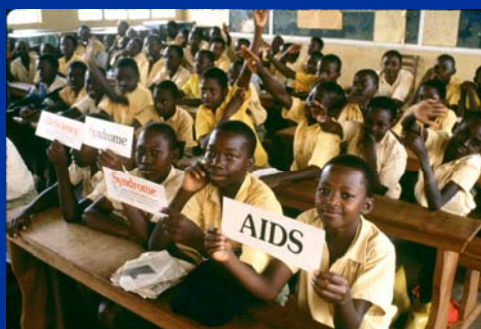

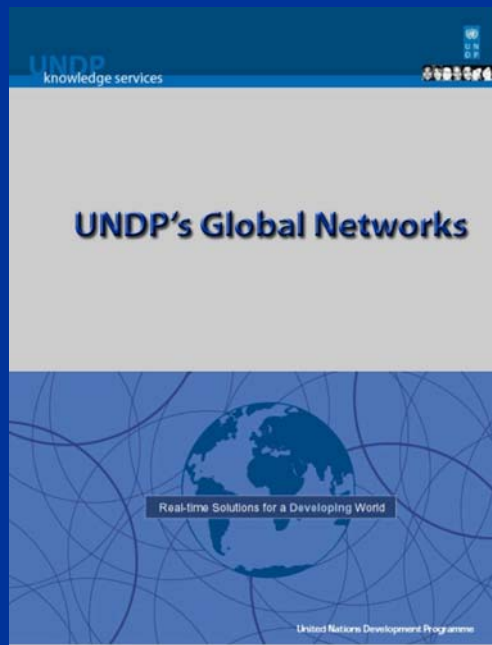
- **Role of Resident Coordinator (RC)**

- Encompass all UN agencies with operational activities for development in a country for the efficiency and effectiveness
- Lead UN Country Teams
- Funded and managed by UNDP

# UNDP as Knowledge Network



- As Global development network in UN System, UNDP developed **Global Networks** to share experience and knowledge among HQ, and field/Country Offices.



- 22 global practice or knowledge networks have been developed.

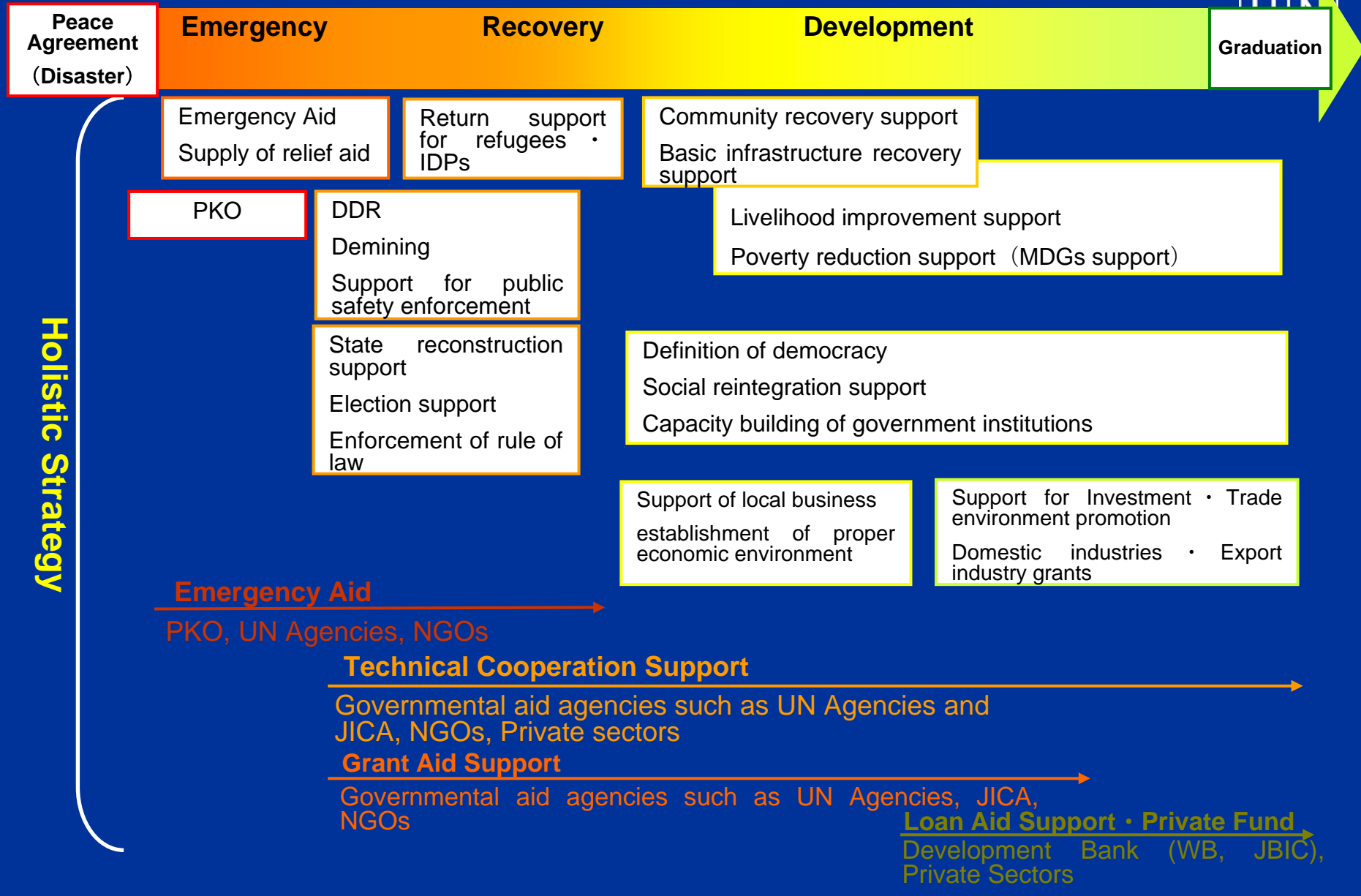

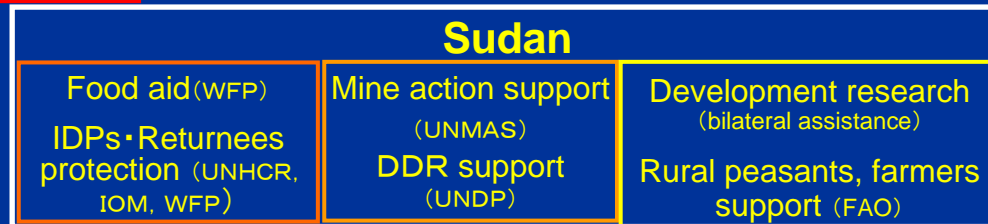
