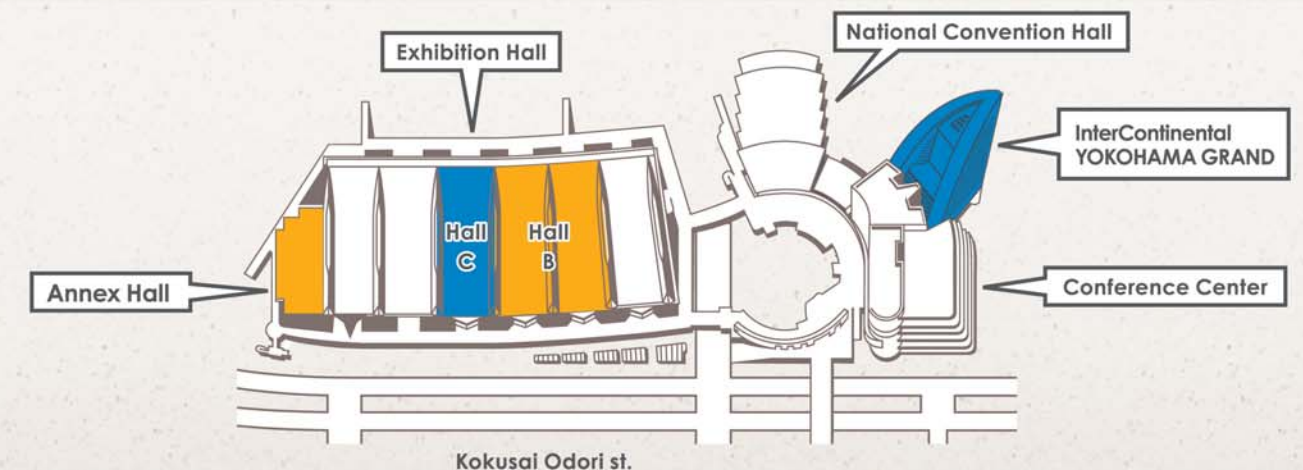


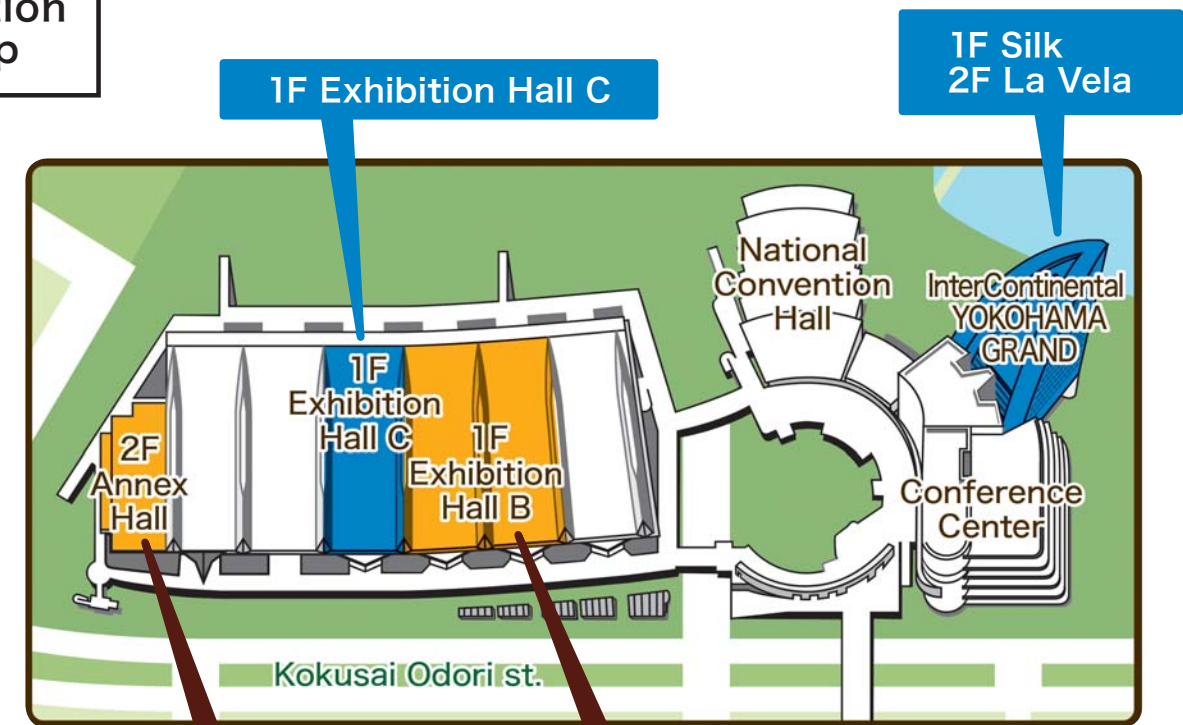

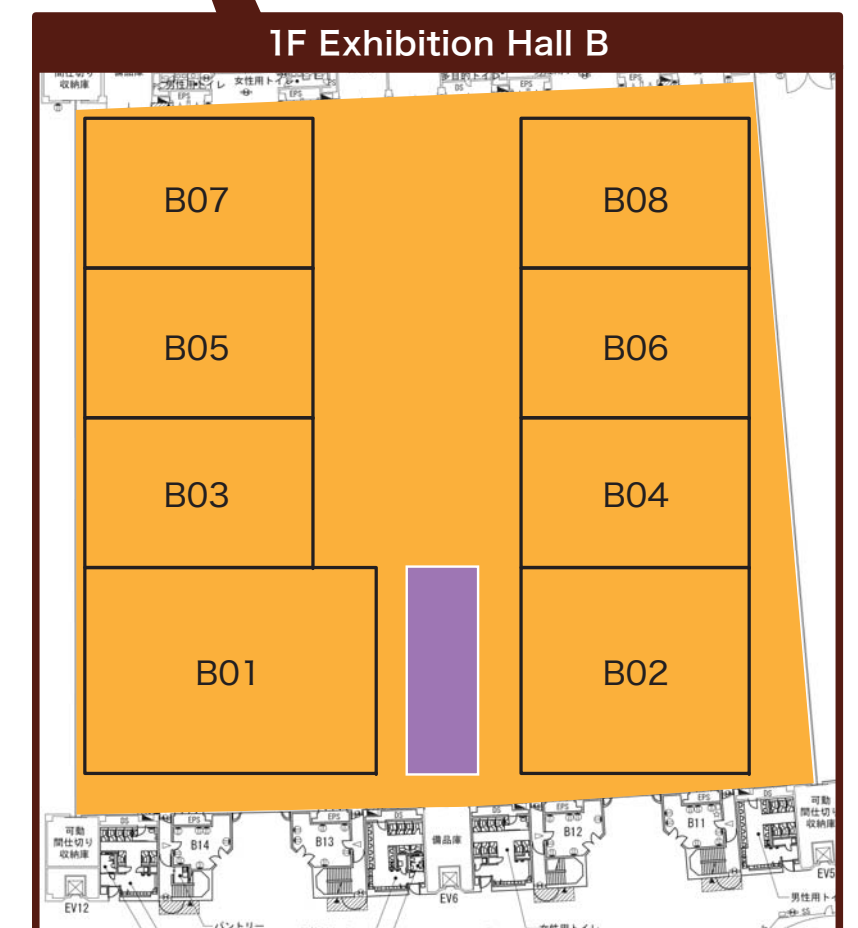
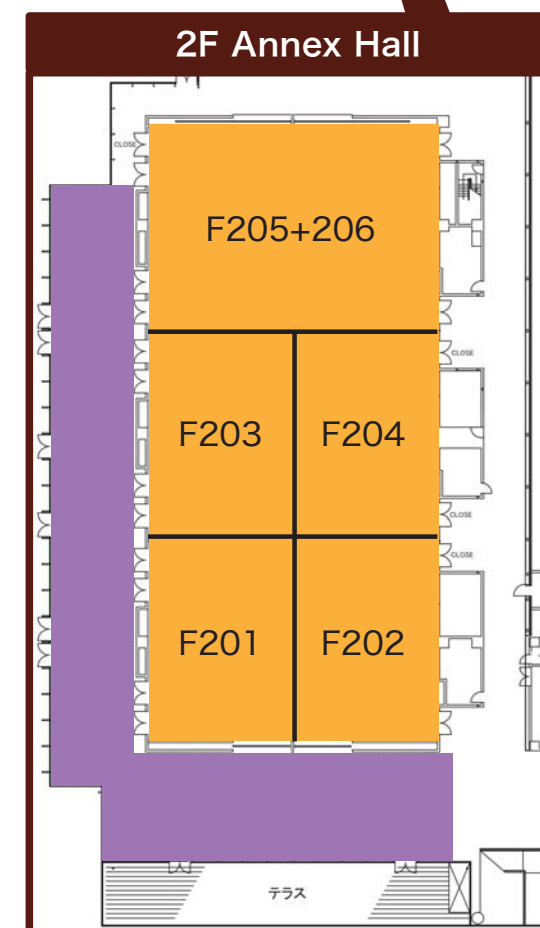

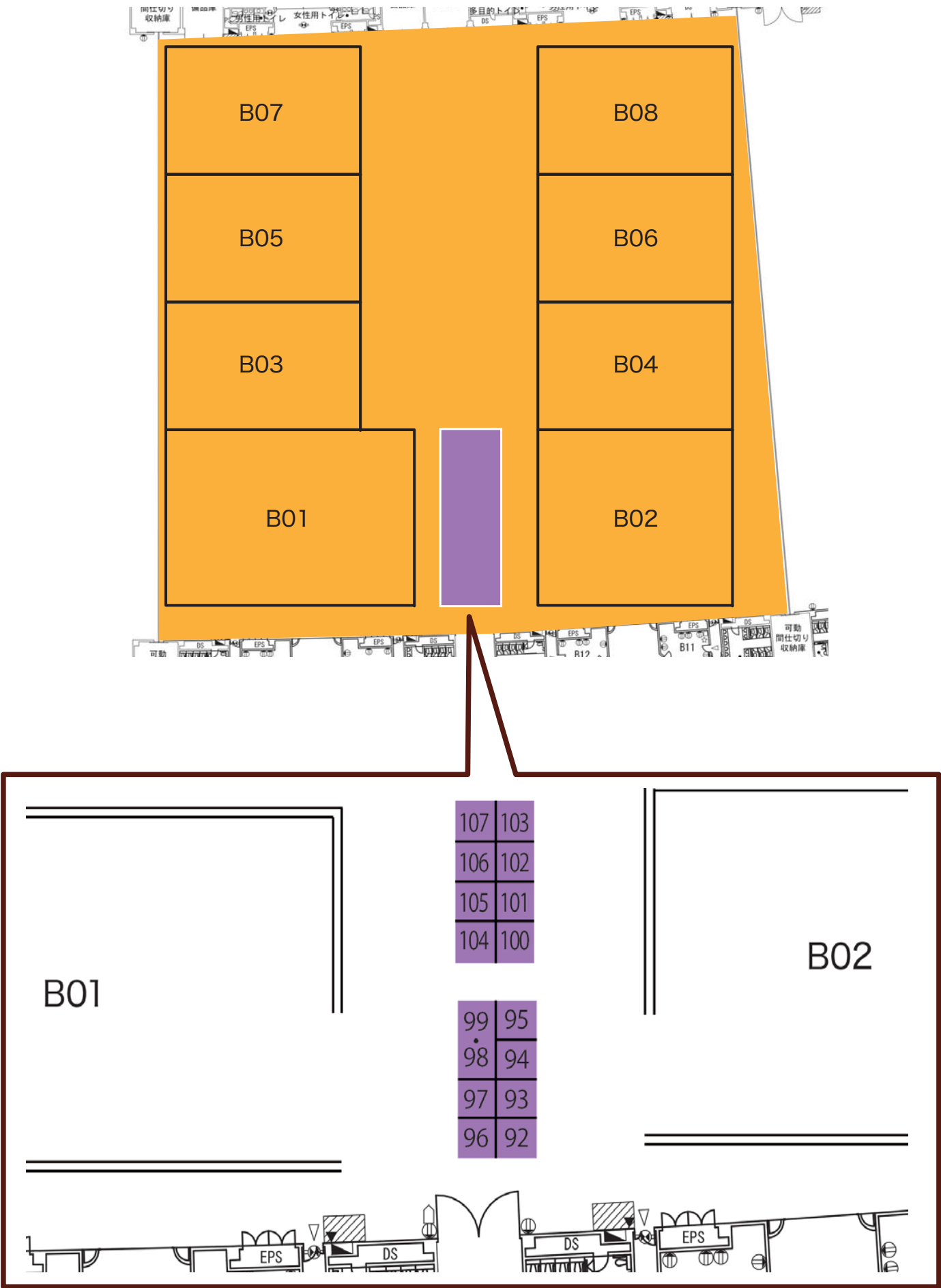
Map of Booth Exhibition and Panel Exhibition / Annex Hall
