

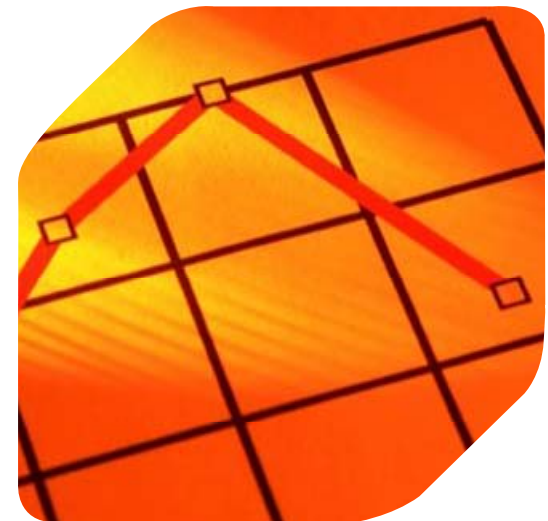
Opinion Poll on Japan in Six ASEAN Countries Databook

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan commissioned TNS Singapore to conduct an opinion poll on Japan in the six ASEAN countries (Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam) during February and March 2008. This poll was conducted by either through interview or online to 300 nationals or permanent residents over 18 years old in each country.

- * Face to Face – Indonesia, Philippines and Vietnam
- * Online – Malaysia, Singapore and Thailand

Interpretation of figures: The numbers in brackets () are results from the previous polls, those on the left are results from 2002 and those on the right are results from 1997.

*The results of the previous polls are shown only for reference. Since the past data is collected by different means (number of samples, methodology, organization under commission, etc., are different), it may not be appropriate to make a definite comparison.

How to use this DataBook

The pink font means the sample size is below 30 and data in that column must be read with caution.

Data in grey means that sample size is below 30.

Data highlighted in yellow means that it is significantly different from the other groups in the same category.

The group that it is significantly different from is marked in the same cell, e.g. 60 G means that this is significantly different from the group in Column G.

Project Background

Managing a country's image has important implications for paving the way in many aspects of a country's dealings with the world – from attracting a steady flow of tourism, to lowering in-country barriers for overseas investment. As part of Japan's on-going efforts to ensure its foreign policies are in-line with public perceptions regionally, regular studies are conducted to explore overall sentiments towards Japan and the Japanese culture.

Research Objectives

Results of such studies will serve as inputs into refining Japan's foreign policies to address any potential areas of concerns, and to continue strengthening efforts to direct the overall image of Japan.
