Total Amount : Over 140million USD

Emergency Assistance : Approximately 55 million USD

1. Medical service and sanitation

- (1) Medical services by Japan Disaster Relief Team in the city of Leogane
 - (a) Medical Team (Jan.18th-25th: a total of 534 people were attended)
 - (b) Japanese Self-Defense Forces Unit
 - (Jan.23th-Feb.13th : a total of 2,954 people were attended)
 - \rightarrow The medical team of the Japanese Red Cross Society succeeded its efforts
- (2) Assistance through international organizations (WHO, UNFPA)

2. Emergency relief goods

Tents, Portable Jerry Cans, etc.

3. Assistance through international organizations

- (1) Food, water, sanitation etc. (WFP, UNICEF, UNFPA, UNOCHA)
- (2) Construction of shelters (IOM, IFRC, UNV)
- (3) Prevention of the spread of infectious diseases (UNICEF, WHO)
- (4) Job creation, Agriculture (UNDP, FAO)
- (5) Education (UNESCO)

Reconstruction Assistance : Approximately 70 million USD



4. Other Reconstruction Assistance

- (1) Rehabilitation of Urban Roads and Drainage in Léogâne City
- (2) Integrated Border Security Management (through IOM)
- (3) Emergency Grant Assistance for the electoral process (through UNDP)
- (4) Contribution to the Haiti Reconstruction Fund (30 million USD)
- (5) Assistance for Reconstruction based on Japan's experience and knowledge
 - Training program on recovery strategy after the big earthquake
 - Anti-seismic Measures in Haiti through Japan-Mexico Partnership Program
 - Dispatch of a Japanese architect to MINUSTAH
- (6) Establishment of Field Office of JICA in Haiti
- (7) Dispatch of a Japanese Aid Coordination Expert to the Ministry of Planning and External Cooperation
- Support for the Relief activities by the Japanese NGOs: Approximately 15 million USD

 - 9 Japanese NGOs up to now have been operating in Haiti from the emergency phase

PKO: A total of 2,200 SDF personnel have been dispatched

Deployment of the Engineering Unit of the Self-Defense Forces to the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH)

(1)Deployment Area: Port-au-Prince

(2)Main Missions:

- ·Clearing rubbles/debris,
- ·Clearing roads to ensure mobility,
- ·Performing small construction work, etc.

(3) Activities:

Clearing away rubble, Land leveling, Road repair, Construction of simple facilities, Transportation of supplies Other activities (Training on the operation of vehicles etc.)

(4) Achievement:

- Cleaning away rubbles and debris from roads in Port-au-Prince, government offices, and museum.
- Land leveling of hospital in Léogâne City (Corporation with Korea's contingent in MINUSTAH)
- Demolition of school for the blind and clearing away rubbles (Cooperation with NGO)
- Demolition of Hôpital Sanatorium de Sigueneau and clearing away rubbles (Cooperation with ODA)
- •Demolition of houses and clearing away rubbles (Cooperation with ODA)
